## BRIDE AND GROOM SHORTBREAD

## For the bride:

- 1. Using a four-pronged dipping fork, coat entire shortbread in white coating, shake and lightly scrape off the excess coating.
- 2. After coating starts to harden, pipe necklace and lace with a number three pastry-tip, held on the end of a stripe bottle, holding the bottle on a slight angle to apply.

## For the groom:

- 1. Dip the wide side of the cookie in white coating about 1/3 of the way up the shortbread, shake and lightly scrape off the excess coating.
- 2. Let harden.
- 3. Dip one side in dark chocolate and then the other side in dark chocolate to make a "V". This forms tux "lapels" leaving the white coating showing as the tux "shirt".
- 4. Use a pointed apple stick dipped in dark coating to make buttons and bow tie with dark chocolate.

\*Note that the groom is upside down from the regular tuxedo shortbread.
