

4269 MILK STRIPED DARK CORN FLAKE CLUSTERS

1. In a large bowl, mix the corn flakes with chocolate, using a rubber spatula. Make sure to coat the corn flakes thoroughly with chocolate.
2. Drop onto parchment paper with a #30 self-cleaning ice cream scoop. Use the scoop to spread the cluster out so that it isn't mounded. The cluster should be approximately 2 ½ to 3 inches in diameter.
3. Before the candy hardens use a squeeze bottle to drizzle with a fine string. Drizzle milk clusters with dark. Drizzle dark clusters with milk. Drizzle peanut clusters with dark.
4. Yield on this batch is 11 clusters.
