

Baby Sweet Baby Basket #4622

Stuff white tissue into the three compartments of the basket so that the ingredients will sit higher and be easier to see. Unwrap the silver-plate baby gift, stuff all the wrappings into the box with the lid on the bottom. Add a colorful piece of tissue to the top so the silver-plate gift shows. In the compartment to the left, add the box of Tuttle's and the Caramel Topping with the bag of Jordan Almonds in front. To the right compartment add the box of mixed pretzels, the Chocolate Topping, and the Holland Mints. Seal and label the two baby bottle suckers and glue them to the tissue beside the silver-plate gift.

Shrink-wrap the entire package. Since the shrink-wrap bag is a bit large, you will find it easier to cut it down to size. Wrap a length of the ribbon to the left of the silver-plate gift. Use the rest of the ribbon for a bow and add a colorful pic to the bow. Place a second pic above the gift compartment. Attach the pacifier, sealed and labeled, to hang in front of the bow. Add the gold cigar to the bow. (If you know the baby's gender you can use a pink or blue cigar.)

This basket is as beautiful as it is practical. It includes not only a silver-plate heirloom for the baby but also a practical basket for organizing the changing table. "Baby Sweet Baby" also includes many delicious Kilwin's treats for the parents.
