

4639 A Taste of Kilwin's

1. Make a 12" x 10" backboard from sturdy cardboard and cover it with Kilwin's gold everyday paper.
2. Fit the backboard to the back of the container and stabilize with crumpled newspaper or Kraft paper. Fill the top of the container and cover well with shred.
3. Attach Caramel Corn and Pecan Brittle to the backboard with stickies – one to the right and one to the left.
4. Between the two bags at the top of the backboard, attach the acetate of mixed nuts.
5. In the middle of the container, place the large sampler acetate in an upright position that reaches from the front lip of the container and rests on the mixed nuts.
6. Place the Fudge topping and Berryblues to the left and the Raspberries & Blackberries and Caramel topping to the right.
7. Make a 30" tall bag. Put the container in the bag and gather up the shrink-wrap at the top, securing with wire. Shrink-wrap over the product, being careful not to heat the topknot.
8. Using two coordinating ribbons, make a double bow, which is made the same as a single bow. (You will need to pull both patterns of ribbons from the center of your loop. Attach bow securely and add two loose streamers – one down each side of the gift.
